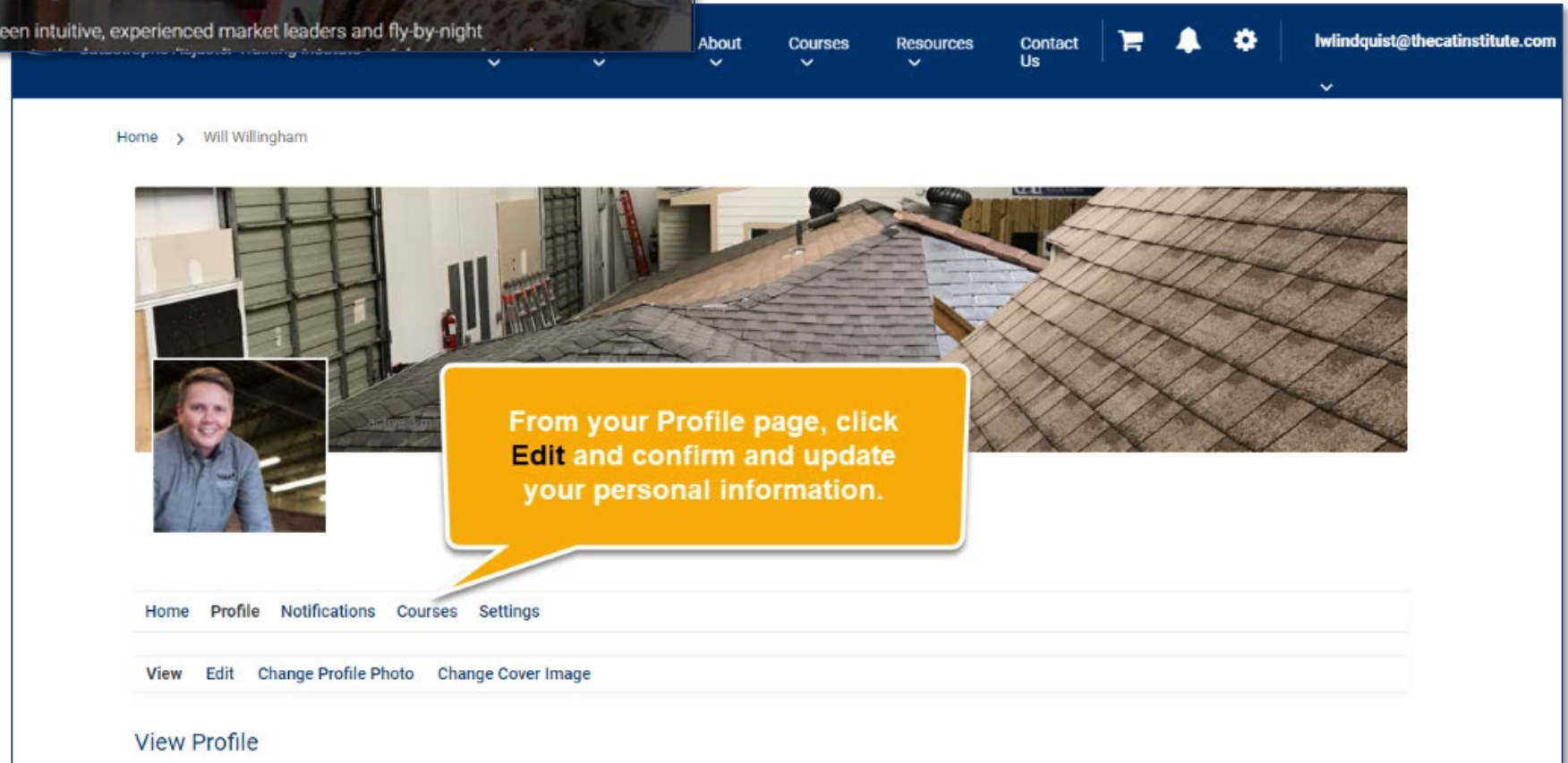

MS Plans Coverage & Endorsements Summary

Following is a summary reference of the MRPIUA Coverage:

MRPIUA Coverage	
Windstorm/Hail	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Coverage excluded inWhere coverage does apply, damage to the interior of a covered building is excluded unless the direct force of wind or hail first damages the building, creating an opening.No coverage for frost or cold weather or for ice (other than hail), snow or sleet whether or not driven by wind.
Deductible	12/1/2014 forward: \$1,000 flat deductible per occurrence, per policy.
Valuation	Policy is written on Actual Cash Value basis.
Other Structures	Insured may elect to use up to 10% of Coverage A limit of liability for Other Structures. Coverage does not increase Coverage A limit and is not in addition to Coverage A.
Lawns, Plants, Shrubs, Crops, Trees	There is no coverage for lawns, plants, shrubs, crops or trees outside of buildings.
Fences & Awnings	Peril of Windstorm or Hail does not apply to damage to fences or awnings.
